1, Standard American Beer. You know

Well, revisit a few of them with



the critical tasting skills we've been practicing. I suggest:

- Category IA Bud Light & Miller Lite. (Different grain bills make for distinctly different beers.)
- Category IB Budweiser or Miller High Life, & MadTree Legendary Lager (Again, different grain bills for the two macros. Legendary Lager is a silver medal winner at the 2022 World Beer Cup!)
- Category IC Genesee Cream Ale & Little Kings Cream Ale (Yes, that Cincy Classic!)
- Category ID Bell's Oberon & Boulevard Unfiltered Wheat Beer

Yeah, that a lot of beers, but they're not expensive and your neighbor will drink them. So buy a bunch and enjoy them after mowing the lawn all summer long!
