


### **June 2023 Brewsletter**

Memorial Day is in the rearview mirror and pool season is upon us! That means it's time to get your water tested... not for swimming but for brewing. Join your **Butler County Brewing Society** for our **June Membership Meeting** and brush up on your water chemistry. This month's KART will see **Dr. Matt Cutter** share some simple ways you can get the most out of that most basic brewing ingredient... **Water**.

Of course before you can hit a target, you have to know where you're starting from. To help, in partnership with **MBW** we are offering **free water chemistry analysis to paid BCBS members**. Just bring a sample of your standard brewing water to the June Membership Meeting. Samples should be in a small mason jar labeled with your name and date. Water reports will be distributed when results are received from the lab.

The June Monthly Membership Meeting will be Sunday, June 11th starting at 7pm. We will again be at MBW Champion Mill, located inside the Warehouse Hotel on the east side of North B Street. Note that we will be skipping First Call this month, but the Homebrew Bottle Share is on like Donkey Kong!
