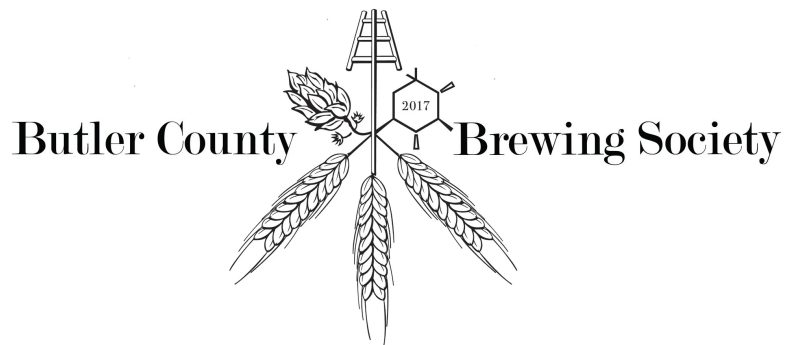




2026 BCBS Holiday Party
